Seneca County has a residency requirement that an applicant must be a resident of Seneca County or one of the six contiguous counties (Cayuga, Ontario, Schuyler, Tompkins, Wayne and Yates) for one month to be eligible for appointment.

PUBLIC SERVICE LOAN FORGIVENESS: College graduates with student loans may be eligible to have part of their loan paid for after being employed in a full-time position at Seneca County. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college with a Master's degree and one (1) year of experience in quality assurance activities; OR
- B. Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college with a Bachelor's degree and two (2) years of experience in quality assurance activities; OR
- C. Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college with an Associate's degree and three (3) years of experience in quality assurance activities; OR
- D. Any equivalent combination of training and experience.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This position involves coordination of the Seneca County Mental Health Departments' Quality Assurance and Improvement Activities. In coordination with the Director of Community Mental Health Services, is responsible for ensuring that the department is adhering to federal and state regulations for the quality of care of patients, billing practices, regulatory compliance, cost reporting and record keeping, and documentation.

Serves as the Compliance Officer for the Mental Health Department;

In coordination with the Director, conducts systematic/periodic audits of the department's operations to determine compliance with, and the efficiency of, the department's compliance program;

Coordinates and assists the Director with staff education and training to ensure understanding of the department's compliance program and its requirements;

May assist the Director with investigation of any information suggesting possible unethical or illegal business practices by the facility or its employees;
