GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Operates one or more types of automotive equipment and performs a variety of manual tasks in connection with such operations; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

Employees in this class perform recurring manual duties in connection with the operation of moderately complex motor equipment. They receive the general directions from a superior but are responsible for the safe and economical operation and care of their equipment on assigned tasks. Periodic inspections are made of work in progress.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only):

Operates a truck in connection with the collection of garbage, ashes, snow and in the transportation of sand, stone, gravel and supplies;

Operates a tractor or truck with power mower, trailer, snow loaders, bulldozer, concrete mixer, stone crusher or other attachment;

Operates a power grader, steam roller, snow plow or power shovel;

Occasionally performs minor repairs on automotive equipment;

Performs manual labor, such as loading trucks, erecting snow fences and cleaning culverts;

Supervises the work of laborers engaged in loading and unloading trucks;

Does the work of a Water & Sewer Maintainer or Laborer when not performing MEO related work.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES & PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the operation of tractors, trucks, and other automotive equipment; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; industry; dependability; good physical condition.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

One year of experience in the operation of some type of automotive equipment, and completion of a standard grade school course; or any equivalent combination of experience and training sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Valid Class B CDL Driver's License with Air Brakes within six (6) months of appointment and maintained during employment.
